Day 1: Arrive in New York transfer to the Manhattan Times Square Hotel. A pass for the airlink shuttle will be included in your documents and will provide transfers from the airport to your hotel the Manhattan located in the heart of Times Square.

Day 2: Included in tour package you will find a 48 hour hop on hop off sightseeing pass combined with a New York City Attraction Pass.. That will allow you to explore New York at your pace. Your Hop on Hop off Pass and attraction pass provides you admission to New York's top Museums and attractions as well as a Statue of Liberty Cruise. **Breakfast included**

Day 3: Today is another day to enjoy the city using your Hop on Hop off Pass. If you don't want to use all of the attractions they can be traded for lunch or dinner at select restaurants. **Breakfast included.**



Day 4: This morning we depart New York for **Niagara Falls where we will stay on the Canadian Side. Please remember a passport is required to cross the border.** Your hotel will be located with in walking distance of the falls and casino. **Breakfast included.**



Day 5: The day begins with either a Maid of the Mist Trip or a **“Journey behind the falls.”** Ride by elevator to the base of the falls and step out onto the viewing platform to see the falls close up. Protective clothing will be provided to keep you dry. You also have the option of sailing on the “Maid of the Mist” and traveling to the base of the falls by boat. Either is a fantastic experience giving you two very different perspectives of the

falls. Continue by motor coach to **Table Rock** for most picturesque view of the falls, along the Niagara Parkway to the **Floral Clock** and a stop at the **Botanical Gardens** for a stroll through the gardens. Tonight we will feature dinner with a panoramic setting overlooking the falls. **Breakfast and Dinner included.**

Day 6: This morning we depart at 8 AM for a journey across New York State to Cape Cod, for a three-night stay at the Hyannis Harbor Hotel. Tonight we feature a New England Lobster Dinner. **Breakfast and Dinner included.**

Day 7: We travel along the **Cape Cod National Sea Shore to Provincetown** where you have the option of going whale watching or taking a trolley tour of Provincetown. For those that choose the trolley tour you will also have the opportunity to go wine tasting. Provincetown is a unique community where the Pilgrims first landed now filled with art galleries and boutique shops. **Breakfast and Dinner included.**



Day 8: This morning depart for **Woods Hole and the Ferry to Martha's Vinyard.** On arrival on the Island you will have a comprehensive tour visiting the towns of **Oak Bluff, Vinyard Haven, Edgartown and Aquina.** In Vineyard Haven see the gingerbread houses and learn the story of the tent meetings on the commons. Aquina is the part of the Island claimed by the native Americans. **Breakfast included.**

Day 9: Before departing Hyannis we will make a stop at the **Kennedy Memorial**. Then on to **Plymouth** where we will see how the Cranberry is harvested and learn a little about the many uses of the cranberry. Samples will be available to taste products made with Cranberries. We step back in time as we visit the **Mayflower II** and learn what it was like to cross the ocean in 1620. It is then on to **Plimouth Plantation** where you will discover how the Pilgrims and the Native American's lived. We encourage our patrons to visit the Native American interpretive center to gain the perspective of the Native American's toward the Pilgrim's. We have all been taught about Squanto and Massasoit in American history but have you ever wondered how they were able to converse with the Pilgrims in English? Tonight we overnight outside of **Boston**.

Breakfast and Dinner included.



Day 10: Our day begins with a visit to historic **Boston, Massachusetts**. Our First stop will be the **USS Constitution**, the oldest commissioned ship in the US Navy. Next we will visit the **North End of Boston** where you will visit the **Old North Church** and see Paul Revere's Home. Then it is on to the famed **Quincy Market** for a bit of shopping and lunch. After lunch transfers to NH **Breakfast**

Day 11: It is off to Coastal Maine where we will explore the **Light House Trail**. Our first stop will be at Nubble Light one of the most photographed points in Maine, followed by a New England Lobster lunch at the famous Colony Hotel. This afternoon we will visit Portland and the famous **Portland Head Light**, as well as other lighthouses in the area. **Breakfast and Lunch included.**

Day 12: We travel North to **Squam Lake**, used as the setting in the Classic movie on Golden Pond. On your cruise of Squam Lake you might spot a bald eagle or a loon flying against a background of New England Fall colors. Enjoy a gourmet box lunch before having an interactive experience at the Squam Lake Science Center starring New Hampshire wildlife. **Breakfast and Dinner included.**

Day 13: Today we will have a taste of **Vermont** as we see how Vermont as we taste some of Vermont's famous products. Our day begins with a stop at the Cabot Creamery Visitor Center, for a sampling of some of Vermont's finest cheeses. Here you will see how cheese is made and packaged and learn the story of this Vermont cooperative.. It is on to Montpelier for a photo stop at the Vermont State House and lunch in the State House Cafeteria. We continue our journey west to Waterbury Vermont home of Ben & Jerry's for a tour and tasting. We will make a stop at Morse farm to see how Maple Sugar is produced and taste this delectable treat. Our last stop will be at Cold Holler for a taste of Vermont made cider, jams jellies and mustards. **Breakfast included.**

Day 14: Transfer to Boston or Manchester for flight home.
